4a. Dates of the 2022 second session of the Executive Board

In decision 2022/3 the Executive Board decided that the 2022 second session will be held for 3 days between 15 and 17 November 2022. These dates now coincide with COP 27 which will be held in Egypt from 6 to 18 November 2022. Options for new dates of the 2022 second session of the Executive Board are as follows:

Option 1: 21-23 November 2022

Option 2: 17-21 October 2022

Option 3: 5-7 December 2022

Option 4: 13-16 December 2022

UN-Habitat’s proposed focus on item 7 will be: **UN-Habitat’s contribution, experiences and added value in urban crisis situations**



Introduction: UN-Habitat's work in urban crisis situations: contexts, principles, approaches, tools, guiding documents

Value added by UN-Habitat in urban crisis prevention and response: building resilience and sustaining peace; operationalizing the humanitarian, development and peace nexus, past successes, future opportunities

Thematic focus: land, housing, urban planning and design, local economic development and financing, basic services, social inclusion, youth, gender

Regional examples and results: Africa, Arab States, Asia and the Pacific, WEOG, Latin America, and the Caribbean.

Strategic partnerships: UNHCR, IOM, UNDP, Global Alliance for Urban Crises, etc.

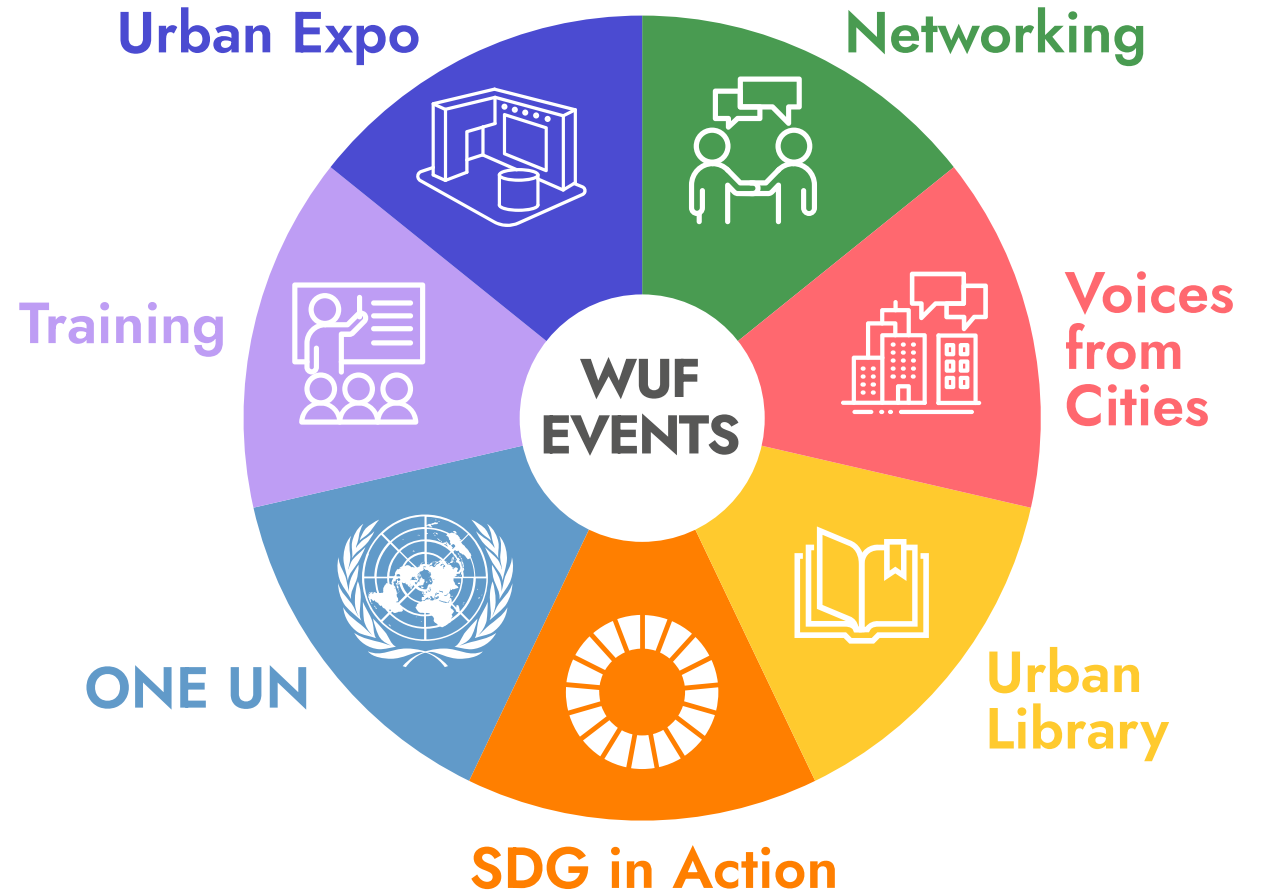

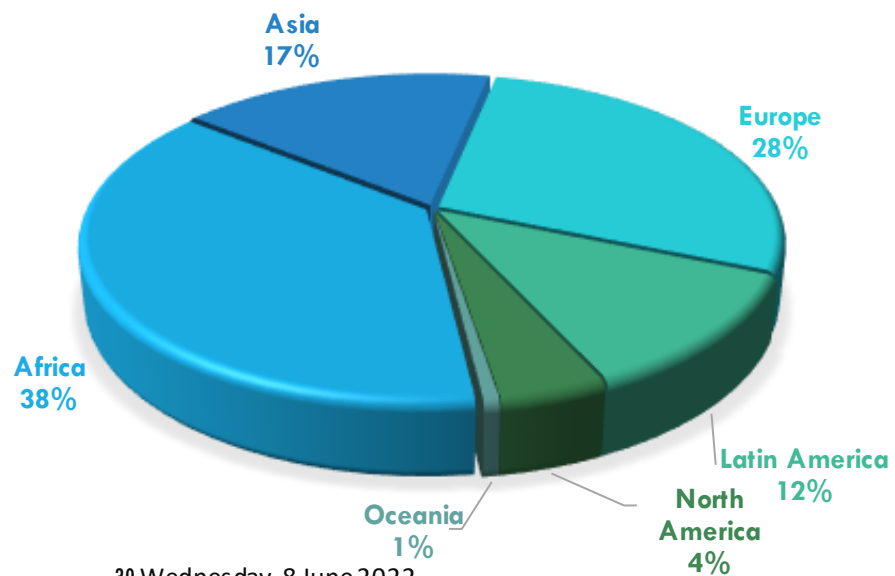

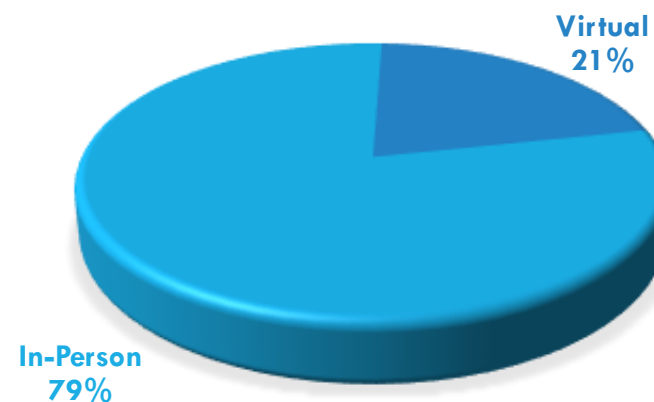
